STONY BROOK ACRES



Welcome to Stony Brook Acres! This beautifully landscaped 20-acre property is located at 1004 Stony Hill Road in Wilbraham, MA. Our 60' X 45' L shaped pool is the setting for both instructional and recreational swimming. The spacious pavilion provides campers with a cool, shady spot for lunch. Our Amish barn is home to many games and activities, and the smaller barn is designed for arts & crafts. The grassy fields give participants ample space for sports, nature, archery and more.

AGE APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS

Your child will gain an appreciation for the outdoors at Stony Brook Acres. Campers will be placed into units according to grade, each with progressive programming. Within each unit, smaller groups are made up of 10-12 boys and girls.

BREAKFAST CLUB (6:30-7:15AM)

Offered at the Scantic Valley YMCA, Breakfast Club is available beginning at 6:30am. Your camper will receive a healthy breakfast and participate in engaging and fun activities. Campers will be transported to Stony Brook Acres beginning at 7:15am to join the Pre-Camp Program. **A minimum of eight (8) children need to be registered for the Breakfast Club Program to run**

Weekly Rate: \$25.00/Session

TRADITIONAL SUMMER PROGRAM (AGES 6-12)

The traditional program is designed for children in kindergarten (entering first grade in September 2019) up to grade five. Children are assigned to appropriate age groups and participate in many activities throughout the day.

- **EXPLORERS** – Ages 6 & 7
- **PIONEERS** – Ages 8, 9 & 10
- **RANGERS** – Ages 11 & 12

TEEN PROGRAM (AGES 13-16)

This program runs for nine, one-week sessions. One day per week, teens will have the opportunity to go on field trips. The rest of the week participants will be at Stony Brook Acres enjoying activities including archery, swimming, sports, arts and more.

FACTS AT A GLANCE: AUTOMATIC WITHDRAWALS, VIA BANK ACCOUNT OR CREDIT CARD, ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL CAMP SESSION PAYMENTS.

The camp day runs 9:00am-4:00pm. Camper drop-off is from 8:30am-9:00am and pick up is from 4:00pm-4:30pm. An authorized parent or guardian (with photo ID) will be required to sign your camper in and out each day.

All costs associated with camp, with the exception of before or after camp care, are covered in the session fee. A completed registration form, medical forms, and deposit for each child is required to hold a spot. Deposits are applied to camp fees and are non-transferable and non-refundable. The YMCA will bill for the balance. Balances are due seven (7) days prior to the start of each camp session.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: The YMCA believes in making our programs and services affordable for all. An application for assistance is available on our website or by calling 413.596.2749. Scholarship determination is based on need and is made available on a first come, first served basis. Scholarships are made possible through the generous contributions of YMCA donors.

FACILITY MAINTENANCE FEE: A one-time only Facility Maintenance Fee of \$10 will be charged to each child upon his/her initial registration and must be paid with the deposit(s). This fee helps with the general up keep of the Stony Brook Acres property, which in turn helps to keep program fees down.

PRE/POST CARE: Before and after care is available at an additional cost. Pre camp operates from 7:00am-9:00am and post camp runs from 4:00pm-6:00pm. Games, sports, movies, crafts and more will be offered during these times. Session 1-8 Weekly fee is \$32/YMCA Members and \$37 Non-members. Session 2 fee is \$26/YMCA Members and \$30 Non-members.

TRANSPORTATION: All parents/guardians are responsible for transportation to and from camp. The YMCA does not offer transportation. For your safety and convenience, we have a large entry way for drop off and pick up. Pick up tags will be issued to each family upon registration.

TO REGISTER: All camp forms are available on our website at www.springfieldy.org or may be picked up from the YMCA. Registration forms must be turned in to the Scantic Valley YMCA Branch. Deposit fees are due at the time of registration. Medical forms are due the day of registered session. For questions please contact the Camp Registrar at 413.596.2749.

CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

Please notify the Camp Registrar at 413.596.2749 as soon as you know you must cancel your child from a session he/she is registered to attend. This allows us to fill your child's spot if there is a wait list. Please remember the \$25/\$50 deposit is non-refundable. The only exception is when there is a note from a doctor stating your child cannot attend the program for a medical reason. The deposit may be transferable if you choose to register for a different session provided there is space available. Your payment for the session, less the deposit, will be refunded. There will be no refunds issued once a session has started.
